# Your profile

As our Project Coordinator Safety & Security, you work in a fast-changing and international environment. You are pragmatic, pro-active, impact-driven and openminded. You coordinate and handle all organizational and Safety & Security project-administrative matters, including necessary implementation activities. You are passionate about building and maintaining relations with teams in Africa and the MENA region.

#### Positioning in the organisation

The Project Coordinator Safety & Security is a position within the Finance & Operations department and you will report to the Director of Finance & Operations.

#### **Role purpose**

The purpose of the role is to ensure all matters safety and security related are effectively coordinated for staff and partners of RNW Media. The role looks at risk management, security protocols, incident reporting guidelines & procedures, and digital safety & security measures. Following trends and keeping colleagues in programme countries aware and updated, whilst ensuring a holistic view of safety and security procedures, is part of the role.

#### What you will be doing

As a Project Coordinator Safety & Security you are, among other things, responsible for:

- Acting as first point of contact and liaison for stakeholders (internal and external) with regard to the planning, organizational matters and implementation processes of RNW Media's Safety & Security policies and objectives;
- Identifying needs and wishes and translating this into a solution;
- Analysing, documenting and processing of lessons learned, which you use to further develop our Safety & Security procedures and processes;



- Coordinating and monitoring the strategic project planning including reporting;
- Documenting the Safety & Security approach, objectives, processes and keeps them up-to-date; and
- Monitoring the progress and deadlines of outstanding activities, identifying (potential) problems and act upon them.

#### What you need to have

Your pro-active way of working, by means of which you are a real team player, makes you a truly valued colleague. Besides this, you have a hands-on mentality, are, accurate and have excellent planning and organisational skills.

You also have:

- At least a bachelor's degree in a relevant field, a masters' degree is a plus;
- 3 to 5 years' relevant experience in international development and working with international teams;
- Good project management/project coordination experience;
- Excellent communication skills, verbally and written; and
- Fluency in English, Knowledge of Arabic, Chinese or French is considered an asset.

#### What do we offer?
